

The Iowa Deer Exchange is the Iowa Department of Natural Resources' new free online database at www.iowadnr.gov/deerhunting where deer hunters willing to provide venison can connect with Iowans who want venison.

Hunters enter their information to the database, including their location. Recipients choose the condition they want the meat when they

ing Prepayment Resolution 2010-15
City Administrator Collins explained that the 2010 resolution approving the prepayment of some bills before the first regular council meeting was outdated. The 2010 resolution listed individual venders. This list of venders has changed over the years. The new resolution gives the City Administrator/Clerk the authority to pay expenses that include but are not limited to payroll, payroll taxes, IPERS, petty cash, utility bills, insurance premiums, loan principal and interest payments, library bills, postage, customer deposit refunds, tuition/seminar/training registration fees, emergency repairs, reimbursement for "out of pocket" expenses for travel, mileage, or supplies and such vendors that offer a discount if paid within a certain time period, or where the city does not have a charge account. It also gives the City Administrator/Clerk the authority to spend up to \$1,000 for emergency repairs. Any amount over \$1,000 requires the verbal approval of three city council member with the mayor being counted as one of the three.
