WHEREAS, The Planning and Zoning Commission, after proper public hearing and notice, has recommended to the Board Supervisors that they amend the Zoning Ordinance and Map by changing the Zoning Districts for the following property; 28.84 acres along Alpha Avenue located in Part of the NE ¼ SW ¼ & NW ¼ SW ¼ & Part of the SE ¼ NW ¼ & SW ½ NW ¼, NSW ¼, N Section 19 of Township 91 North, Range 6 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Clayton County, Iowa, From the current zoning district of Agricultural (A-1) to Heavy Industrial (M-2) to allow reopening of a rock

quarry on the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT OR-DAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Clayton County, lowa that the Zoning Ordinance be amended as follows:
