Keehner moved, Doepcke se-  
conded to accept and place on file  
the Post-Election Audit Report &  
Auditor Certification for the Special  
Election held September 13, 2022.  
Ayes: Doepcke, Keehner. Motion  
carried.  
The Board reviewed projects to  
be paid with American Rescue Plan  
Act funds. Keehner moved, Doep-  
cke seconded to move forward with  
street signs for \$21,300.00 and dig-  
itization of plats in the Recorder's  
Office for \$12,673.11. Ayes: Doep-  
cke, Keehner. Motion carried.  
Engineer Casey Stickfort provid-  
ed a departmental update outlining  
current and future projects. Stickfort  
also provided a cost estimate on  
the feasibility to blade each gravel  
once per month. The estimate for  
906.2 miles for seven months would  
be \$325,092.08 in fuel costs. This  
would be approximately 93% of the  
total fuel budget of \$350,000.00,  
without factoring in snow removal.  
The Board discussed current job  
openings. Keehner moved, Doep-  
cke seconded to approve the post-  
ing for position of Assistant Shop  
Foreman. Ayes: Doepcke, Keehner.

Purpose: Amend the zoning or-  
dinance and map of Clayton County,  
Iowa by changing the zoning district  
boundaries, all in compliance with  
the Clayton County Comprehensive  
Plan.  
WHEREAS, The Planning and  
Zoning Commission, after prop-  
er public hearing and notice, has  
recommended to the Board Super-  
visors that they amend the Zoning  
Ordinance and Map by changing the  
Zoning Districts for the following  
property; 2.45 acres in the Frac-  
tional Northwest Quarter (NW ¼),  
Southwest Quarter (SW ¼), exclud-  
ing Lot One (1) in Section Six (6),  
Township Ninety-five (95) North,  
Range Four (4) West of the Fifth  
(5th) Principal Meridian.  
From the current zoning district  
of Agricultural (A-1) to Riverside  
Recreational (R-4) to allow the 2.45  
acres to be used for a small camp-  
ground for five (5) units.  
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT OR-  
DAINED by the Board of Supervi-

sors of Clayton County, Iowa that  
the Zoning Ordinance be amended  
as follows:  
The Zoning District Designation  
on the Official Zoning Map for the
