LUANA CITY COUNCIL **MINUTES OF OCTOBER 5, 2023**

The Luana City Council held their regular monthly meeting Thurdays October 5, 2023, at 7:00 pm. with Council Members Lonnie Baade, Kevin Boddicker, Todd Olson, Jackie Radloff-Schneider, Luke Steege present. Absent: None. Mayor Jerry Schroeder called meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes of September meeting were reviewed and approved upon a motion by Boddicker, second by Baade, carried unanimously.

Steege motioned to pay all monthly claims totaling \$26,754.74, Olson second, carried unanimously. Receipts for the month totaled \$43,101.97 Radloff-Schneider motioned to pass Res. 10-2023 T.O.F, Steege second, carried unanimously. Council reviewed reconciled reports.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and place for the pub-lic hearing and meeting on the matter of the FY2023 Annual Financial Report at 7:07 pm. The Mayor then asked the Clerk whether any written objections had been filed by any City resident or property owner to the proposal. The Clerk advised the Mayor and the Council that no written objections had been filed. The Mayor then called for oral objections to the proposal and none were made. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the time for receiving oral and written objections to be closed. Olson motioned to pass Res. FY2023AFR , Radloff-Schneider second, carried unanimously. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the measure duly adopted.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and place for the public hearing and taking action on the proposal to enter into a Sewer Revenue Loan and Disbursement Agreement at 7:10 pm. The Mayor then asked the Clerk whether any written objections had been filed by any City resident or property owner to the proposal. The Clerk advised the Mayor and the Council that no written objections had been filed. The Mayor then called for oral objections to the proposal and none were made. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the time for receiving oral and written objections to be closed. After due consideration and discussion, Council Member Baade introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Council Member Steege. The May or put the question upon the adop-

tion of said resolution, RES. 10.1-2023, and the roll being called, the following Council Members voted: Ayes: 5 Nays: 0. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the resolution duly adopted as hereinafter set out.

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore proposed to borrow money and enter into a Sewer Revenue Loan and Disbursement Agreement (the "Loan and Disbursement Agreement") with the Iowa Finance Authority (the "Lender") and to issue in accordance therewith Sewer Revenue Bonds (the "Bonds") in a principal amount not to exceed \$514,000 to provide funds to pay the costs, to that extent, of planning, designing, and constructing improvements and extensions to the Utility (the "Project"), and has published notice of the proposed action and has held a hearing thereon on October 5, 2023; and WHEREAS, it is necessary at this time to authorize and approve the issuance of a \$514,000 Sewer Revenue Loan and Disbursement Agreement Anticipation Project Note (IFA Interim Loan and Disbursement Agreement) (the "Project Note") pursuant to the provisions of Section 76.13 of the Code of Iowa in anticipation of the receipt of and payable from the proceeds of the Loan and Disbursement Agreement (the "Loan Proceeds") in order to pay authorized costs in connection with planning and designing the Project.

Steege motioned to approve Sewer Revenue Loan and Disbursement Agreement Anticipation Project Note, second by Radloff-Schneider, carried unanimously.

Council reviewed Geotech Proposal from Terracon to complete requirements for lagoon project, which consist of defining the extent of the bedrock outcrop and defining the amount of soil fill available. Boddicker motioned to accept proposal from Terracon not to exceed \$18,200.00, second by Baade, carried unanimously. Council reviewed update on La-

goon Project provided by MSA. Steege motioned to pass Res. 10.2-2023 Clayton County Emergency Mgmt. E-911 Service Board Appointment, Boddicker second, carried unanimously. Roll call vote: AYES 5, NAYS 0. Whereupon, the Mayor declared the measure duly adopted.

Baade motioned to approve building permit for a 48'X32' storage

building at 525 Main Street permitting all city ordinances and city codes are followed, Boddicker second building permit, carried unanimously.

Council discussed unlicensed vehicles within city limits being in violation of city code. Administrator Humble was instructed to prepare letters to be delivered.
