NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION FOR CLAYTON COUNTY, IOWA

Notice is hereby given to all eligible voters in Clayton County, Iowa, that a General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

Please read carefully as your polling place may have changed through the reprecincting process. All voters in Clayton County will be receiving a postcard around the time of this publication showing your polling place.

The polling places will open at 7:00 AM and close at 8:00 PM. A listing of precincts and their respective polling place locations are as follows:

Boardman-Highland-Read: Clayton County Office Building, 600 Gunder Rd NE, Elkader (For voters in Boardman, Highland, and Read Townships and the City of Elkader)

Buena Vista-Millville: Millville County Shop, 35180 Hwy 52, Guttenberg (For voters in Buena Vista and Millville Townships and the City of North Buena Vista)

Cass: Strawberry Point Civic Center, 401 Commercial St, Strawberry Point (For voters in Cass Township and the City of Strawberry Point)

Cox Creek-Sperry: St Paul's Fellowship Hall, 700 Washington St, Volga (For voters in Cox Creek and Sperry Townships and the City of Volga)

Clayton-Garnavillo: Garnavillo Community Building, 106 W Niagara St, Garnavillo (For voters in Clayton, and Garnavillo Townships and the Cities of Clayton and Garnavillo)

Elk-Mallory-Volga: Elkport-Garber Community Center, 120 Main St, Elkport (For voters in Elk, Mallory, and Volga Townships and the Cities of Elkport and Garber)

Farmersburg-Wagner: Farmersburg Community Center, 4 E Adams St, Farmersburg (For voters in Farmersburg and Wagner Townships and the Cities of Farmersburg and Saint Olaf)

Giard-Monona: Monona Community Center, 104 S Egbert St, Monona (For voters in Giard and Monona Townships and the Cities of Luana and Monona)

Grand Meadow-Marion: Turner Hall, 119 E Greene St, Postville (For voters in Grand Meadow and Marion Townships and the City of Postville)

Jefferson: Guttenberg Municipal Building, 502 1st St, Guttenberg (For voters in Jefferson Township and the Cities of Guttenberg and Osterdock)

Lodomillo: Edgewood City Hall, 203 W Union St, Edgewood (For voters in Lodomillo Township and the City of Edgewood)

Mendon: Marquette Community Center, 102 North St, Marquette (For voters in Mendon Township and the Cities of Marquette and

McGregor)

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's Office by November 14, 2022 at 12:00 PM. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. Absentee ballots are available now in the Auditor's Office located at 111 High St NE – Suite 102 in Elkader. Voters may vote in person through 4:30 PM on Monday, November 7, 2022. The deadline to request an absentee ballot to be mailed has passed.

All absentee ballots must be received by 8:00 PM on Election Day to be considered on time to be counted. A voted absentee ballot may NOT be turned in to the polling place for counting; however, the voter or the voter's designee may bring the ballot to the Auditor Office's by the time the polls close on Election Day.

Regular office hours: 8:00 AM - 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday. Additional hours: Open until 5:00 PM on Monday, October 24, 2022, and Friday, November 4, 2022. Open Saturday, November 5, 2022, 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM.

Shall the following amendment to the Constitution be adopted?
Summary: Provides that the right of the people of Iowa to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed. The sovereign state of Iowa affirms and recognizes the right to keep and bear arms as a fundamental right. Any and all restrictions of this right shall be subject to strict scrutiny.

Full Text: Article I of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is amended by adding the following new section: Right to keep and bear arms. Sec. 1A. The right of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed. The sovereign state of Iowa affirms and recognizes this right to be a fundamental individual right. Any and all restrictions of this right shall be subject to strict scrutiny.
