Within ninety days after the end of the licensee's fiscal year, the licensee shall transmit to the commission an audit

of the licensee's total gambling operations, including an itemization of all expenses and subsidies. All audits shall be conducted by certified public accountants authorized to practice in the state of Iowa under Chapter 542 who are selected by the board of supervisors of the county in which the licensee operates.' WHEREAS, the certified public accounting firm of Marcum LLP, is experienced in performing audits of gambling

operations, is registered and or licensed to perform such services in the State of Iowa. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Clayton County Board of Supervisors hereby appoints Marcum LLP accounting firm to conduct the annual audit for the licensee, Casino Queen Marquette, Inc. dba Casino Queen

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this appointment of Marcum LLP shall remain in effect and automatically renew each year until the Board of Supervisors receives a request from the licensee, Casino Queen Marquette, Inc. dba Casino Queen Marquette, to appoint another certified public accounting firm to perform the annual audits contemplated under Iowa Code 99F.13.
